

# Featured Program

### Deaf Program

Arundel Lodge provides services for Deaf and hard-of-hearing individuals who seek community behavioral health treatment. We employ sign language interpreters to facilitate communication with hearing staff members and other community providers. We also employ staff members who are themselves deaf, and knowledgeable about the needs of Deaf and hard-of-hearing individuals, and communicate using American Sign Language (ASL). Through these services, Arundel Lodge makes all of their programs, including Supported Employment, Day Program, Residential Services, and the Outpatient Mental Health Clinic, accessible to Deaf and hard-of-hearing individuals to support their recovery.



Recently, the Deaf Program was the recipient of a \$10,000 grant from the Green Family Foundation that went towards the purchase a new minivan, which was of great need. The purchase of the van helps facilitate getting clients to and from doctor appointments, daily activities, grocery shopping and more.

Clients who are a part of the Deaf Program get to experience fun events and outings such as Gallaudet University's Homecoming, DINGO (Deaf Bingo), CBAD (Chesapeake Bay Association of the Deaf) events, Deaf bowling league, and more!
