Our awesome First Step team will continue providing counseling, education and support to adults 18 and older who have substance use disorders, mental health disorders, or co-occurring behavioral health disorders at the new location: 1819 Bay Ridge Avenue,

First Step Recovery Program at Arundel Lodge is certified through the State of Maryland to provide three outpatient levels of care: Early Intervention, Outpatient services, and Intensive Outpatient services.
